AGENDA APPROVAL

PURPOSE

The purpose of the meeting was to consider a motion to approve a recommendation from Cliff Hendrix, Public Works Director to award a revised base bid and add alternate one for resurfacing S. Rountree St., Green St., Huiett St., Smith St., Boston St., Mincey St.,

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and Ellis St., along with a water main upgrade from a 2” galvanized to a 6” PVC line on S. Rountree St. between Pine St. and Vertia St. replacing all service laterals at an estimated construction price of \$738,133.08.

Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to a motion to approve a recommendation from Cliff Hendrix, Public Works Director to award a revised base bid and add alternate one for resurfacing S. Rountree St., Green St., Huiett St., Smith St., Boston St., Mincey St., and Ellis St., along with a water main upgrade from a 2” galvanized to a 6” PVC line on S. Rountree St. between Pine St. and Vertia St. replacing all service laterals at an estimated construction price of \$738,133.08.
