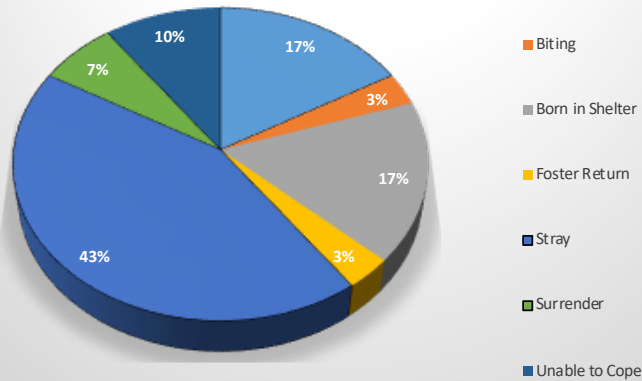

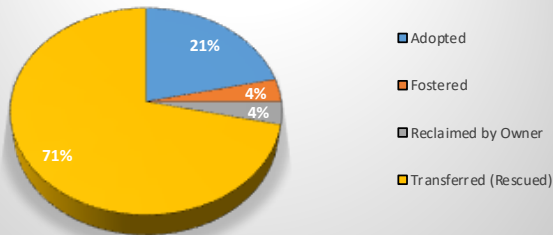

Reasons for Entering the Shelter

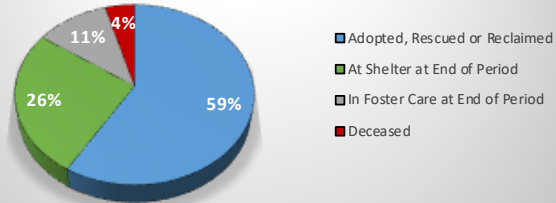


Reasons For Leaving the Shelter
