CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME

Mayor Trapnell called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Councilman Boyd led the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

Councilwoman Colson gave the invocation.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the called meeting was to discuss approving an ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances, City of Metter, Georgia to allow for Sunday Package Sales and On-Premises consumption of malt beverages, wine and distilled spirits; to provide for adoption and an effective date; and to provide for other lawful purposes. This is the first reading.

Councilman Boyd were concerned about two separate issues being presented in one ordinance. They wanted to know what would happen if only one of the alcohol questions were to pass. Mr. Mosley phoned the city attorney who agreed this is a valid point. He told the council that he would research it and get back to them before the second reading of the ordinance.

After no further discussion, Councilwoman Kilcrease made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilman MacGregor seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.
