CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME

Mayor Pro tem Kilcrease called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Councilman Boyd led the Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION

Councilwoman Colson gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilwoman Colson made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Councilman MacGregor seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

PURPOSE

To consider a motion to approve a concept for the Metter Police Department headquarters and authorize the architect to complete the construction documents and advertise for the project.

Mr. Frank D'Arcangelo of Martin, Rule and Associates Architects, Inc. was present at the meeting to present to City Council the drawings for the renovations to the old Metter Elementary School building which will house the Metter Police Department. He also had drawings of the new sign. Mr. D'Arcangelo presented a few different options for the City Council to consider. Chief Seckinger recommended that Council choose option #2 for the front parking layout and add the sign and parking area as an alternate. Councilman Boyd said he has a problem with the police patrol vehicles parking in the back and all the rooms being in the front of the building. Chief Seckinger said he has looked at the plans and agrees with them, but he has never actually been in the building. Council decided that they would like for Chief Seckinger to take a look inside the building and make sure he thinks the layout is workable. Councilman MacGregor made a motion to table this issue until the regular meeting on Monday, February 9, 2015 to give

Chief Seckinger time to take a look at the building. Councilman Boyd seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.

ADJOURNMENT

After no further discussion, Councilwoman Colson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Thomas seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.
