

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Sealed proposals for the Metter Fire Hydrant Repair Project will be received by the City of Metter at Metter City Hall, located at 49 South Rountree Street, Metter, Georgia until 3:00 PM on February 07, 2019. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

The work to be done consists of 21 locations throughout the city for hydrant repair, 1 location to add 6" hydrant valves and 13 locations for the installation of a new M & H 5 1/4" hydrant with a hydrant valve. All work shall be completed within 60 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed, which is expected within 10 days of the bid opening. There will be a nonmandatory pre-bid meeting on January 29, 2019 at 10:00 AM at Metter City Hall.

A list of the locations is open for public inspection at the Metter City Hall, located at 49 S. Rountree St. Metter, Georgia. Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond and shall be secured by a surety company, certified check or cashier's check in an amount equal to at least 10% of the amount of the bid. A contract performance and payment bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount will be required of the successful bidder. Bidders must also submit at least 5 references of work that has been done in reference to this project.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375, which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours Standard Act.

The contractor, or any subcontractor, submitting a bid for utility contracting, as defined in O.C.G.A. Section 43-14-2 to a utility system as defined in said section, shall conform to O.C.G.A. Section 43-14-8.2 et seq. with reference to Utility Contractor's Licenses and shall submit the bid with the license numbers, as issued by the Division of Utility Contractors, affixed on the outside of the bid envelope.
