

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Metter, Georgia has tentatively adopted a 2022 Millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 7.63 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall, 49 South Rountree Street, Metter, Georgia on Thursday, August 18, 2022 at 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. An additional public hearing on this tax increase will be held at City Hall, 49 South Rountree Street, Metter, GA on Monday, August 29, 2022 at 5:30 pm. Immediately following the public hearing on Monday, August 29, 2022 a called meeting will be held to adopt the final millage rate.

The tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 11.665 mills, an increase of .607 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 11.058 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$24.28 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$300,000 is approximately \$72.84.
